Aim 2 - NURTURE AND DEVELOP THE WHOLE CHILD

We believe you have the right to be properly cared for. We believe these rights apply to everyone, whatever your race, religion, abilities, whatever you think or say and whatever type of family you come from. Therefore:

<p>Staff will Help ensure you are happy. Listen to you and appreciate your needs and problems. Celebrate achievements and praise your successes and efforts.</p>	<p>Children will Care for each other. Be kind and helpful. Praise each other. Be respectful, tolerant and caring to everyone. Share our problems with a grown up.</p>
<p>Parents will Praise your efforts as well as your achievements. Share concerns appropriately.</p>	<p>Governors will Recognise and praise the achievements and efforts of the school, staff and children.</p>

Aim 3 - MAKE A POSITIVE CONTRIBUTION

We believe you have the right to meet together and join groups and organisations, as long as this does not stop other people from enjoying their rights. We believe you should be guided to use your rights properly and say what you think should happen and have your opinions taken into account. Therefore:

<p>Staff will Ensure your voice is heard and listen to you. Help you build relationships with others.</p>	<p>Children will Listen to others and let other people make their own choices.</p>
<p>Parents will Ensure you attend school and are punctual. Avoid taking you on holiday in term time where possible.</p>	<p>Governors will Objectively take into account the views of the whole school community in deciding what is best for the school.</p>

Aim 4 - LEAD AND BUILD AN EFFECTIVE TEAM

You have the right for us to consider what is best for each child. We believe we should all work as a team that treats you fairly, regardless of ability, race, religion, age or gender in order to provide child-centred, active learning opportunities that help you achieve your best. Therefore:

<p>Staff will Treat you fairly, with respect and as an individual. Teach you to follow the golden rules and be responsible, showing respect, tolerance and care for others.</p>	<p>Children will Work as a team and treat each other fairly.</p>
<p>Parents will Support the school's vision, aims and policies. Work with the school to support the behaviour policy and teach you to be responsible and show respect, tolerance and care for others.</p>	<p>Governors will Be critical friends to the school, asking questions and making suggestions. To be part of the school team, working with parents, staff and children. Ensure there is equality of opportunity for all.</p>

Aim 5 - BE HEALTHY, FEEL GOOD

You have the right to be properly cared for and be provided with good quality care, clean water, nutritious food and a clean environment in order to develop healthily. You have a right to relax and play and to join in a wide range of activities. Therefore:

<p>Parents will Prepare you for school, including providing breakfast and the conditions for a good night's sleep. Ensure you are dressed in the school uniform and bring your book bag.</p>	<p>Governors will Ensure the school encourages healthy lifestyles.</p>

Aim 6 - STAY SAFE

You have the right to be properly cared for and protected from violence, abuse, neglect and harm. Therefore we will provide a secure environment that is positive and supportive and teaches you to respect and care for each other. Therefore:

<p>Staff will Help keep you safe. Help you be free from bullying and discrimination. Help you understand dangers and help you make the right choices. Tell your family of any problems or changes to your learning or behaviour.</p>	<p>Children will Look after everyone and listen to the adults who look after us. Not bully or harm each other. Recognise dangers and make the right choices.</p>
<p>Parents will Support the school's anti bullying policy. Help you understand dangers and help you make the right choices. Respect staff and not behave aggressively or violently.</p>	<p>Governors will Ensure that the school is a safe environment.</p>

Aim 7 - PROVIDE A QUALITY LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

We believe you have the right to an environment that is good enough to meet your mental and physical needs. Therefore:


