Our topic this half term is

Nursery Rhymes

The children will be making a variety of cards and letters for the different characters, get well cards for Humpty Dumpty and Jack and Jill, posters to help Little Bo Beep find her sheep as well as interviewing characters to find out who pushed Humpty off the wall.



## Suggested activities to do together at home

Read books together at home and talk about them.

Recite nursery rhymes together and make up some of your own.

Sing counting songs together and play number games.

Make a card or write a letter to a nursery rhyme character.

Act out some nursery rhymes together.

Make a collage picture of your favourite nursery rhyme character.

We look after everything and everyone.

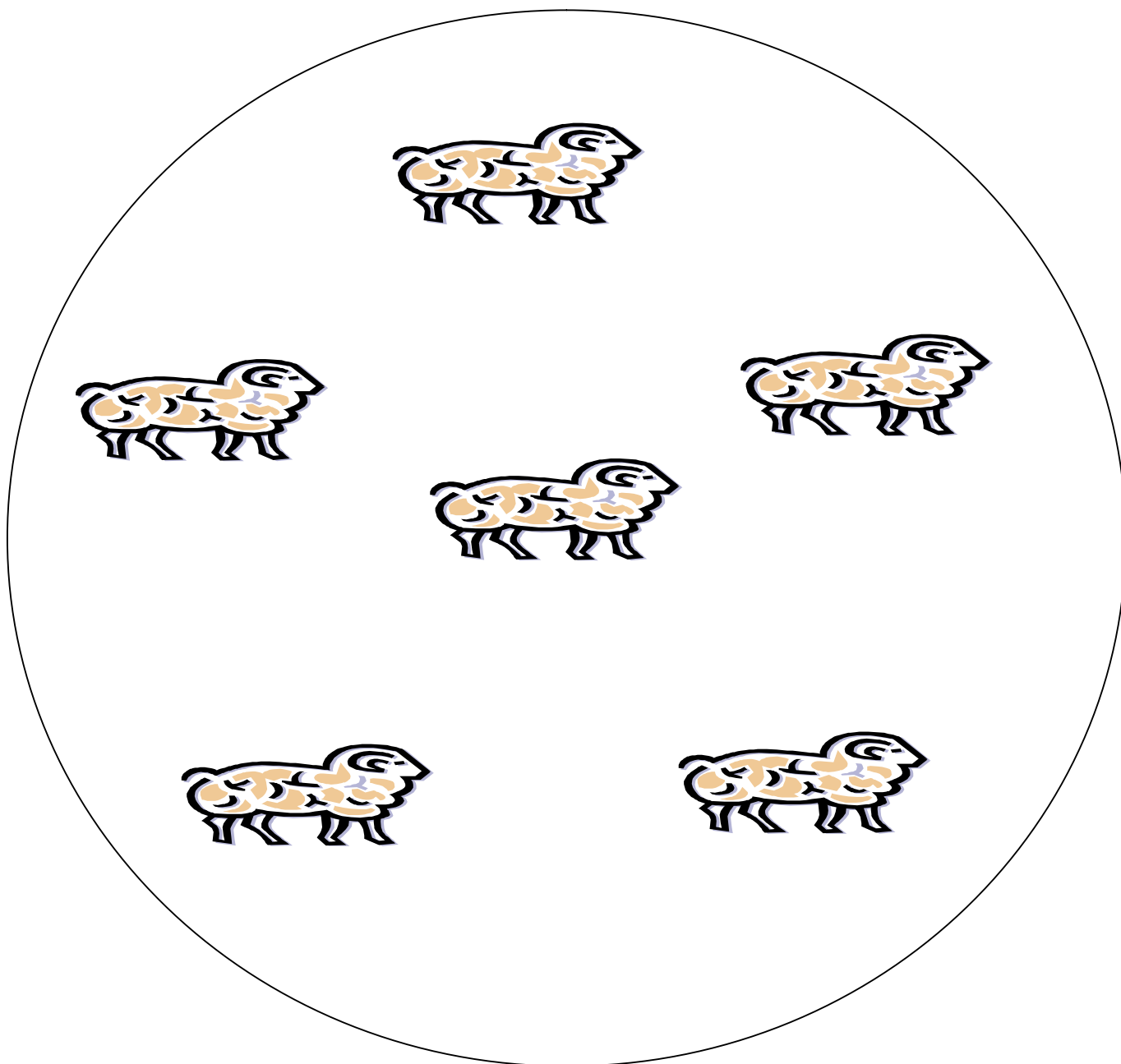
We do what an adult asks the first time.
